\*Utility Ordinance, Section 17, Paragraph 6: Customers living in mobile homes or buildings will also be required to make a \$25.00 sewer deposit. This deposit is refundable when service is disconnected at the location after City personnel have inspected and reported that the sewer line has been properly plugged to eliminate the possibility of mud, rocks, or debris being washed into or placed in the sewer line. Should a violation occur, the deposit will be retained by the City in order to re-cap the sewer line.

Guidelines for Setting Up a Mobile Home/Building:. The location of a mobile home or building on a lot shall be such that there is at least a minimum of 12' clearance from the front property line, 6' from back property line and 3' from adjoining property lines. In addition, there shall be a minimum of 12' between any other mobile homes or buildings located on such lots. Owners of mobile home/buildings will comply with State standards code regarding minimum standards for proper blocking, anchoring and securing of all mobile units. Local regulations require underpinning and individual metering and service connections A copy of the Ordinance is available upon request.

## All Mobile/Manufactured Homes/Buildings:

- This Permit should not be construed as a Permit to Move a mobile home or building.
- Your home/building are subject to periodic inspection for compliance to local Ordinance standards/regulations.
  - Failure to supply required information within prescribed time may cause delays in obtaining utility services or jeopardize continued service.
